COVID-19 Vaccination Program

Many nurses have contacted the College to enquire about the latest development of the vaccination program and the way to be engaged for its implementation after the government has launched it.

On 8 January 2020, the Secretary for the Civil Service and Secretary for Food and Health jointly called a meeting to update representatives of health professions on their plan for the COVID-19 vaccination program. The highlights were:

- (1) The Prevention and Control of Disease (Use of Vaccines) Regulation (Cap. 599K) were published in the Gazette on December 23, 2020, which provides the legal framework under the present state of public health emergency to bring in COVID-19 vaccines for emergency use.
