# Clinical Assessor Accreditation

### ***Introduction***

The College of Nursing, Hong Kong is pleased to announce the operation of an Accreditation Scheme for the Clinical Assessor.

### ***Accreditation of the Clinical Assessor***

The main purpose of accreditation is to provide a uniform standard of professional competence, so that Clinical Assessor can be formally recognised. The system of accreditation can also help to ensure the quality of this nursing service to the community. The individual practitioner may also benefit from career development.

### ***Accreditation Panel***

Applications will be considered by the Accreditation Panel which consists of prestigious professional nurses.

### ***Eligible Applicants***

Interested nurses who satisfy the following criteria will be eligible for application:

- a. Have bachelor degree, a minimum include certificates, diplomas and degrees awarded by bona fide educational institutions
- b. Registered nurse with the Nursing Council of Hong Kong
- c. Member of the College of Nursing, Hong Kong
- d. Have successfully completed both courses offered by the College of Nursing, Hong Kong
  - (i) Certificate Course in Clinical Teaching and Assessment and
  - (ii) Certificate Course in Mentoring in Nursing
- e. Required to take the role as mentor at clinical setting

### ***Application Procedure***

The applicant must undertake the following:

1. Complete the Application Form obtained from the College of Nursing or download at [www.cnhk.org.hk](http://www.cnhk.org.hk).
2. Submit completed application form with current curriculum vitae and photocopies of all qualifications.
3. Provide the addresses and contact numbers of 2 referees who can give evidence of profession experience and expertise.
4. Undergo professional interview if necessary.
5. Pay an application fee of HK\$200 (which is non-refundable); and an additional HK\$300 will be charged for successful accreditation covering a period of 3 years.
6. A numbered "Clinical Assessor" badge will be issued to successful applicants.
