Requirements

The submission should consist of:

1. An abstract, in a length between 300 to 500 words;
2. In the form of scientific paper or clinical case sharing;

3. The layout of submission should be in the order of the following subheadings: Background / Purpose, Method, Results and Conclusion;
 4. The use of tables, graphs or images is not allowed in abstract;
 5. Abstract could be submitted in English or Chinese;
 6. Number of abstract submission is not limit;
- Authors will take sole responsibility for their views.

Criteria

1. ensure originality of the paper;
2. address one of the sub-themes listed above;
3. be scientific, practical, current and relevant;
4. be precise, concise and coherent.

Review of abstracts

All submissions will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee of College of Nursing, Hong Kong (CNHK). Abstracts accepted for presentation will be published in the programme booklet. Number of presentation or posters are not limited.

The result of the review will be emailed to the main author and c.c to the other author as well). The list of accepted papers will be posted on the CNHK's website on **4 October 2019.**
